EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 24-196

(Amending Executive Order 24-194)

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 24-194 to handle charges pending against Amber Koepelman for burglary of an occupied dwelling and criminal mischief; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 24-194 reflected the defendant's name as Amber Koepelman while her correct name is Amber Hoepelman; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 24-194 is amended to reflect the defendant's name as Amber Hoepelman.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 24-194 is ratified and reaffirmed.
