EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 24-205

(Amending Executive Order 23-89, as extended by Executive Order 24-90)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 23-89, as extended by Executive Order 24-90, to handle charges pending against Eric Franklin for burglary of an occupied dwelling; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable SUSAN S. LOPEZ, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Eric Franklin has been charged with violation of probation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 23-89, as extended by Executive Order 24-90, is hereby amended to include the charge of violation of probation.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 23-89 is ratified and reaffirmed.
