OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 24-41

(Amending Executive Order 23-249)

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 23-249, to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle pending charges of attempted armed car jacking, second degree murder, attempted second degree murder, tampering with physical evidence, and grand theft against Lekambrick Aljenard Hanna; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Lekambrick Aljenard Hanna has been charged with violation of probation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 23-249 is hereby amended to include the violation of probation case.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 23-249 is ratified and reaffirmed.
