OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 19-130 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-309)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-309 to the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against James Platt, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that an affidavit has recently been filed against James Platt, Jr. for sale of methamphetamine within 1,000 ft. of a place of worship and schools; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MELISSA W. NELSON, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegation in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 18-309 is hereby amended to include the pending allegation of sale of methamphetamine within 1,000 ft. of a place of worship and schools.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-309, is ratified and reaffirmed.
