EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 25-21

(Amending Executive Order 24-198)

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 24-198 to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Conrad Witte for battery – domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Conrad Witte has been subsequently arrested for misdemeanor battery.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 24-198 is hereby amended to include the arrest for misdemeanor battery.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 24-198 is ratified and reaffirmed.
