### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 25-86

(Amending Executive Order 24-50, as Extended by Executive Order 25-66)

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 24-50, as extended by Executive Order 25-66, to handle charges pending against Trevoy Williams for burglary (dwelling) and grand theft; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Trevoy Williams has since been arrested for robbery/no firearm or weapon (2 counts), aggravated battery on a person 65 years of age or older, and elderly abuse.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS**, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 24-50, as extended by Executive Order 25-66, is hereby amended to include the arrest for robbery/no firearm or weapon (2 counts), aggravated battery on a person 65 years of age or older, and elderly abuse.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 24-50, as extended by Executive Order 25-66, is ratified and reaffirmed.
