Dear Governor DeSantis:

I have had the honor and privilege to have served as a Circuit Judge in the 10th Judicial Circuit, mostly in Polk County since August, 2010. Prior to that I served as an Assistant State Attorney in Polk County since November, 1987, and was Polk County Felony Director for the State Attorney's Office for 18 years preceding my appointment to the bench in 2010. All together, I have been in public service for approximately 40 years. I have decided it's my time to retire.

Therefore, I wish to announce my resignation/retirement effective at 11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2024, a few days prior to the end my current term which ends on January 6, 2025. In line with current legal authority, it is my understanding that your acceptance of my announcement of retirement prior to the election qualifying period next week will result in an appointment of a successor by you to my position, which is my hope and desire.

Please formally accept my resignation/retirement effective as indicated above as soon as practical.
