On behalf of Governor DeSantis, I am requesting that you convene the First Judicial Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission for the purpose of selecting and submitting to the Governor the names of highly qualified lawyers for appointment to the First Judicial Circuit and Escambia County Courts. These appointments are to fill the vacancies created by the resignations of Judge Michael A. Flowers, effective April 14, 2022, and Judge Amy P. Brodersen, effective April 18, 2022. The Governor strongly prefers submission of the maximum number of nominees (six) for each vacancy.

The Commission's deadline for completion of this undertaking is corrected and extended to **Friday**, **May 27**, **2022**. In cases where an additional discretionary extension is needed, as authorized by Article V, Section 11(c) of the Florida Constitution, please contact me.

Administrative support for the Commission will be provided by the Governor's Office, pursuant to section 43.291(7), Florida Statutes. This includes all essential administrative needs such as document distribution, public announcements, and the like.
