EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-40

(Amending Executive Order 21-134)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRIAN HAAS, State Attorney for the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 21-134 to the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Marquis Larmar McCullough a.k.a. Marquis Lamar McCullough for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, resisting an officer with violence, trafficking in Fentanyl (4 to 14 grams), possession of drug paraphernalia, attempted tampering with/physical destruction of evidence and felon in possession of a firearm. He is also under investigation for two homicides; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Marquis Larmar McCullough a.k.a. Marquis Larmar McCullough also has pending charges for possession of a controlled substance-Fentanyl, delivery of a controlled substance-Fentanyl and tampering with physical evidence.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

<u>Section 1.</u> Executive Order 21-134 is hereby amended to include the charges of possession of a controlled substance-Fentanyl, delivery of a controlled substance-Fentanyl and tampering with physical evidence.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 21-134 is ratified and reaffirmed.
