EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 24-131

(Amending Executive Order 24-89)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 24-89, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle pending charges of petit theft (felony) against Paul Keon Hayes; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Paul Keon Hayes has been subsequently arrested for petit theft (felony), petit theft – 2nd degree, and trespassing occupied structure or conveyance, and allegations have been made for petit theft – 2nd degree.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 24-89 is hereby amended to include the arrest for petit theft (felony), petit theft – 2nd degree, and trespassing occupied structure or conveyance, and allegations of petit theft – 2nd degree.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 24-89 is ratified and reaffirmed.
