EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 24-136

(Amending Executive Order 24-126)

WHEREAS, Executive Order 24-126 was issued assigning the State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Michael Anthony Brown Jr. for robbery with a firearm, giving a false name to a law enforcement officer, and violation of probation; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 24-126 was intended to reflect that the victim, as opposed to the defendant, is related to an employee of the state attorney's office.

WHEREAS, this Executive Order amends Executive Order 24-126 as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

<u>Section 1.</u> Executive Order 24-126 is hereby amended to reflect that the victim, as opposed to the defendant, is related to an employee of the state attorney's office.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 24-126 is ratified and reaffirmed.
