EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-102

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 11-55)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 11-55, to the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle the case regarding the arrest of Paul Robertson Brown for burglary of a dwelling with battery (2 counts); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are now additional charges for felony violation of probation and leaving the scene of an accident, violations of the criminal laws of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional charges in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-55 is hereby amended to include the additional charges of felony violation of probation and leaving the scene of an accident.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-55 is ratified and reaffirmed.
