OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-237 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 11-221)

WHEREAS, the Honorable DENNIS WARD, State Attorney for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 10-194 to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Karen Miller-Maness; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2011 Executive Order 11-221 was issued extending Executive Order 10-194 as the executive assignment had not been completed; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 11-221 incorrectly stated that Dennis Ward was assigned under Executive Order 10-194 to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit instead of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-221 is hereby amended to reflect that Dennis Ward, State Attorney for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, is assigned to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Karen Miller-Maness.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-221 is ratified and reaffirmed.
