### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-50

WHEREAS, the Honorable ROBERT L. JARVIS, JR., State Attorney for the Third Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RICK SCOTT that allegations had been made against Johnny Ray Bristol and Earnest Robinson for cutting and selling timber from another owner's property, a violation of the criminal laws of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ROBERT L. JARVIS, JR. has also advised the Governor that the victim is an employee of the state attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ROBERT L. JARVIS, JR., to avoid any appearance of conflict of interest or impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified himself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney with respect to the investigation and potential prosecution of this case and all related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM P. CERVONE, State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable WILLIAM P. CERVONE discharge the duties of the Honorable ROBERT L. JARVIS, JR., pursuant to Section 27.14, Florida Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant

to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1.

The Honorable WILLIAM P. CERVONE, State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the "Assigned State Attorney," is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable ROBERT L. JARVIS, JR., State Attorney for the Third Judicial Circuit of Florida, as they relate to the investigation, potential prosecution and all matters related to Johnny Ray Bristol and Earnest Robinson.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the Third Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed above.

Section 3.

All residents of the Third Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4.

The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including March 18, 2012.

Section 5.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before February 18, 2012, if additional time is required.
