EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-113

(Special Elections – Circuit Court Judge, 20th Judicial Circuit, Group 23)

WHEREAS, no person has qualified to run for election for Circuit Court Judge, 20th Judicial Circuit, Group 23, and therefore no person will be elected at the general election to fill said office; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 100.141(1), Florida Statutes, the Governor is required, after consulting with the Secretary of State, to issue an order declaring the dates special elections shall be held;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, as Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed, and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1.

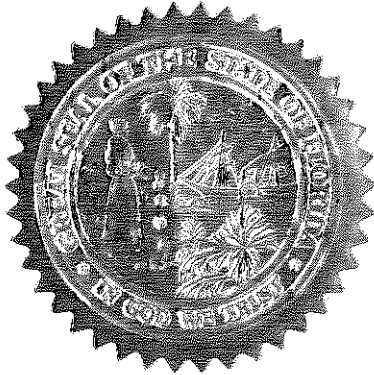
A special primary election for Circuit Court Judge, 20th Judicial Circuit, Group 23, shall be held on August 14, 2012.


Section 2.

A special general election for Circuit Court Judge, 20th Judicial Circuit,

Group 23, shall be held on November 6, 2012, to fill the judicial office for a term of office beginning January 8, 2013.
