OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR **EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-170**

(Special Election - Loxahatchee River Environmental Control District)

WHEREAS, Chapter 2002-358, §4 (2), Laws of Florida, provides that that the Governing Board of the Loxahatchee River Environmental Control District ("Board") is elected; and

WHERAS, no person qualified to fill the offices on the Board, Areas 2 and 4, and therefore no person will be elected at the general election to fill the offices; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 100.101(1), Florida Statutes, no person will be elected to fill the offices which are required to be filled by election at the general election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 100.141(1), Florida Statutes, the Governor is required, after consulting with the Secretary of State, to issue an order declaring the dates special elections shall be held;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, as Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed, and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1.

A special election is required to fill the offices on the Board, Areas 2 and 4.

Section 2.

A special general election shall be held on November 6, 2012, in Martin County and Palm Beach County,
