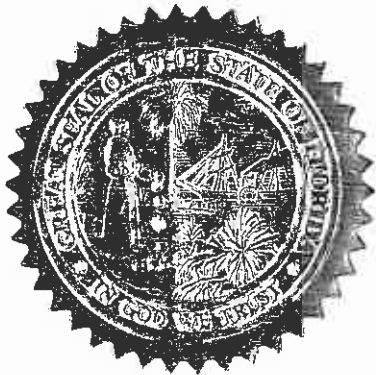


STATE OF FLORIDA

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-193

WHEREAS, Ed Havill, Lake County Property Appraiser, died on August 18, 2012; and  
WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(b),  
Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent  
officer; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an  
Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in  
office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority  
vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of  
Ed Havill, a vacancy exists in the Office of the Lake County Property Appraiser, which I shall fill  
in compliance with the law.
