EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-248

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-212)

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-212 to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Sarah A. Smith for burglary of a dwelling and grand theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Trevor Elmore has been identified as Sarah A. Smith's co-defendant and has been arrested for burglary of a dwelling and grand theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the charges or allegations pending against Trevor Elmore; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-212 is hereby amended to include co-defendant Trevor Elmore who was arrested for burglary of a dwelling and grand theft.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-212 is ratified and reaffirmed.
