EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-250

WHEREAS, Dani Lynn Lolli-Pearson was appointed to the Manatee Housing Authority on September 18, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(f), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the officer's unexplained absence for sixty consecutive days; and

WHEREAS, Dani Lynn Lolli-Pearson last attended a meeting of the Manatee Housing Authority on April 23, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Dani Lynn Lolli-Pearson's sixtieth day of unexplained consecutive absence from office occurred on June 22, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to Dani Lynn Lolli-Pearson's sixty days of unexplained consecutive absence from office as a commissioner on the Manatee Housing Authority, a vacancy exists on the Manatee Housing Authority, Seat 2.
