EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-253

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-225)

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 11-110 to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle pending charges against Brittany Elyse Kron which resulted in a sentence that included probation; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 11-110 expired on May 23, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-225, to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle new charges pending against Brittany Elyse Kron for possession of legend drug and possession of paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that due to the most recent charges there is an allegation of violation of probation in the case assigned under Executive Order 11-110; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional allegation and/or charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the

Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-225 is hereby amended to include the additional allegation of violation of probation.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-225 is ratified and reaffirmed.
