OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-50 (Amending Executive Order 12-42)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL F. MCAULIFFE, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Circuit, accepted an executive assignment from the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit relating to William Chris Blane who was charged with three counts of fraudulent transactions – falsification or concealment of material facts and one count of second degree grand theft; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred in Section 1 of Executive Order 12-42 referring to State Attorney Michael J. Satz as State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 12-42 should reflect the Honorable Bruce H. Colton as the State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 12-42 is amended to reflect that the Honorable Bruce H. Colton is the State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-42, assigning the State Attorney Michael F. McAuliffe, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial to discharge the duties of the Honorable Bruce H. Colton, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit in matters related to William Chris Blane, is ratified and reaffirmed.
