EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-56

(Amending Executive Order 12-53)

WHEREAS, Executive Order 12-53 extended Executive Order 11-22 assigning the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Circuit, to the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit relating to John Flannery and Zachary McKeown; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred in Executive Order 12-53 referring to the case being assigned to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 12-53 should reflect that the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit was previously assigned by Executive Order 11-22 to the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against John Flannery and Zachary McKeown;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-53 is amended to reflect that the Honorable Katherine

Fernandez Rundle, State Attorney for the Eleventh Circuit, is assigned to the Sixteenth

Judicial Circuit regarding charges pending against John Flannery and Zachary McKeown.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-53 is ratified and reaffirmed.
