OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-146 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-200)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-200, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Alexander Imperato for grand theft, dealing in stolen property, and false ownership of pawned items; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Alexander Imperato has filed an application for expunction as a No Information was filed in this case; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional filing in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-200 is hereby amended to include the application for expunction by Alexander Imperato.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-200 is ratified and reaffirmed.
