OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-226 (Amending Executive Order 13-222)

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2013, Executive Order 13-222 was issued assigning the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Circuit, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit to handle charges relating to Arieda Isaula and Yvette Hernandez; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 13-222 should reflect that the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit has been assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Arieda Isaula and Yvette Hernandez;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 13-222 is amended to reflect that the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit regarding charges pending against Arieda Isaula and Yvette Hernandez.
