OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR **EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-95**

(Executive Order of Removal)

WHEREAS, Susan Barbosa, is presently serving as a Notary Public of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2011, Susan Barbosa entered a guilty plea to grand theft, a violation of section 812.014(1) and (2)(c), Florida Statutes, in case number 2010-014090-CF, which constitutes a third-degree felony; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2011, Susan Barbosa entered a guilty plea to fraudulent use of personal identification information, a violation of section 817.568(2)(a), Florida Statutes, in case number 2010-007178-CF, which constitutes a third-degree felony; and

WHEREAS, section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, provides that any person who pleads guilty is deemed to have been convicted, and authorizes the Governor to remove a public official convicted of any felony; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Florida, that Susan Barbosa be immediately removed from the public office, which she now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Susan Barbosa is hereby removed from the public office of Notary Public.
